

## A message from Father Mark

Our Gospel lesson from last Sunday is one of my favorites: The Wedding at Cana. What intrigues me is the dynamic between Jesus and his mother, Mary. First, Mary announces to Jesus, "They have no wine." Jesus responds with the enigmatic, slightly haughty, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My time has not yet come." But then Mary turns to the servants and says, "Do whatever he tells you to do." From that point, Jesus tells the servants to fill six jars with water, and off we go. Basically, Mary just ignores Jesus' objection. Beyond that, she starts giving instructions that contradict his words!

The text doesn't tell us why Jesus hesitated beyond the strange statement that his time had not yet come. But I wonder if maybe Jesus just didn't feel quite ready. Maybe he was a little nervous about such a display. And what if Mary knew that about her son? By putting him on the spot a little, Mary gently pushed Jesus and encouraged him to take that first big step into public ministry.

And who doesn't need a push from time to time? Who among us doesn't need a little encouragement when we're a little unsure of ourselves or what we should do? Pushed out of false beliefs about our abilities, worth or effectiveness. Pushed out of our ideas that we'll just be in the way or that God has somebody better mind. We can all be that person who says, "You know, I really enjoyed your insights in our last Bible study. Have you considered leading a Bible study yourself? I think you'd be fantastic at it." There are people just waiting for someone to give them that tiny boost of confidence to launch them into new areas of ministry or service. We can all be that person.
