



A message from Father Mark

For a relatively short gospel passage, our reading from this last Sunday is a dense one. One of the central things Jesus says in this passage is that he and the Father are one, by which he means that he and God do the same work. "The works I do in my Father's name testify to me," Jesus says. It is impossible to distinguish between the work that Jesus does and the work that God does in the world because Jesus shares fully in it.

It is this relationship between Jesus and God that the sheep of Jesus' flock will understand. And it is this relationship that demonstrates God's radical love for the world. In the mystery of the incarnation, God made flesh, God becomes tangibly, palpably available to humanity in the person of Jesus. For John, those who believe this about Jesus, who see the works of God in Jesus's life and ministry, have access to God in a way never before possible. That is some good news for us.

Question of the Week: In what specific ways has God called you into partnership with Jesus, to participate in God's work in the world?

Supply priest coming to Advent for June. We have secured a temporary Supply Priest to cover Sunday services in June, 2025 (June 8,15,22,29). He is the retired Reverend Harold Lockett of Atlanta.

The Rev. Dr. Harold Lockett is a retired Episcopal Priest in the Diocese of Atlanta. He is the former Associate Priest of St Paul's Episcopal Church in Atlanta, the former Rector and Pastor of St Timothy's Episcopal Church in Decatur Georgia, and the former Chaplain/Director of Absalom Jones Student Center and Chapel in the AUC.

Since graduating from the C.H. Mason Theological Seminary, ITC, he has served as an Army Chaplain, as a ACPE Supervisor in Training, as a Hospice Chaplain, as a Pastoral Educator for Organ and Tissue Donation for Transplantation. He is retired from the US Army Chaplaincy after 21 years of military service.

He is a graduate of the University of Texas at El Paso, Texas (BBA), C. H. Mason Theological Seminary (M. Div, D. Min), and the Virginia Theological Seminary (Diploma of Anglican Studies). He is married to Dr. Carol Marsh-Lockett, a retired professor of English at Georgia State University, and they have two children: Amanda and Joseph.
