A message from Father Mark

Our gospel lesson this morning John was part of Jesus's goodbye message to his disciples. This took place at the Last Supper. Naturally, the disciples were sad. They wondered how they would cope after he was gone.

There are times when we feel alone and we don't know what will happen to us. At times like these it's natural for us to ask ourselves, "What's to become of me?" The peace Jesus offers is not the same peace that the world offers. Christ's peace is the kind of peace we feel inside even when the world around us is falling apart. Jesus gives us this peace freely, without expecting anything in return except for the hope that when we are changed by this peace, we might pass it on to others.

That's why, whatever our circumstances, we can take these words to heart: "Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." If it's not obvious, God loves us more than we could ever imagine. Our task is to make that love known to others so that they, too, can access the peace of God which is readily available to all of us.

Question of the Week: Name a time when the peace of God was most obviously present with you. How would you describe that experience to a person who is seeking the same thing?
