

Father Lockett will be conducting Sunday services in June. He is a retired Episcopal Priest in the Diocese of Atlanta. He is the former Associate Priest of St Paul's Episcopal Church in Atlanta, the former Rector and Pastor of St Timothy's Episcopal Church in Decatur Georgia, and the former Chaplain/Director of Absalom Jones Student Center and Chapel in the AUC.

Since graduating from the C.H. Mason Theological Seminary, ITC, he has served as an Army Chaplain, as a ACPE Supervisor in Training, as a Hospice Chaplain, as a Pastoral Educator for Organ and Tissue Donation for Transplantation. He is retired from the US Army Chaplaincy after 21 years of military service.

He is a graduate of the University of Texas at El Paso, Texas (BBA), C. H. Mason Theological Seminary (M. Div, D. Min), and the Virginia Theological Seminary (Diploma of Anglican Studies). He is married to Dr. Carol Marsh-Lockett, a retired professor of English at Georgia State University, and they have two children: Amanda and Joseph.
